Circle or highlight the course you are choosing on your course card. If you choose to sign up for an honors class, please have a conversation with your current teacher.

As an 8th grader, you need to register for 8 courses.
A]1 8th grade students are REQUIRED to take:

- ELAR or Honors ELAR
- Math or Algebra I Honors *HS Credit Course - grade counts toward GPA (prerequisite: Honors Math 7)
- Science or Honors Science
- American History or Honors American History
- College and Career Readiness (YR)
- PE (only if you have not taken it in 6th and 7th grade)


## OPTIONAL choices for 8 th grade:

Please note - you have to have taken at least 1 fine art credit (Band, Orchestra, Choir, Art, Theater Arts) over the course of your middle school career.

- Art I, II, or III
- Art I - *HS Credit course - grade counts towards GPA
- Band
- String Orchestra
- Treble \& Chorale Choir
- Theater I, II, or III
- Spanish I *HS Credit Course - grade counts towards GPA
- Honors Spanish I *HS Credit Course - grade counts towards GPA
- Honors Spanish III *Dual Language students only. HS Credit Course - grade counts towards GPA
- ASL I (Course may be offered online ) *HS Credit course - grade counts towards GPA
- Principles of Human Services *HS Credit Course - Grade counts towards GPA
- Fundamentals of Computer Science *HS Credit Course-Grade counts towards GPA
- Engineering Essentials *HS Credit Course - Grade counts towards GPA
- Yearbook - application required - pick one up in the front office
- Student Aide (YR) - application required - pick one up in the front office
- PE PALS (YR) - application required - pick one up in the front office
- AVID Elective (YR) - application required - pick one up in the front office
- Athletics (YR) - if you have a signature from the coaches and wish to participate in team sports.
