CCES 4th Grade Expectations

Beginning of the day:

- School starts at 7:35 each day.
- When KCUB begins, you should stand up and say the pledges respectfully and remain standing for the 'Moment of Silence'. After the 'Moment of Silence' you may sit down and remain silent (Noise Level Zero) as you listen to the announcements.
- Students arriving at school after the announcements have begun at 7:35 am must report to the office with their parent to sign in and get a tardy slip.
- If there is a change in transportation, a transportation change note (or any other note) should be given to your teacher first thing in the morning.

School Rules for Appropriate Behavior: Ready! Respectful! Responsible!

- 1. I am prepared for class with supplies.
- 2. I turn in assignments on time.
- 3. I listen to and follow directions.
- 4. I walk quietly in line, and keep my hands and feet to myself.
- 5. I stay on task.
- 6. I am courteous and respectful to both adults and students.
- 7. I control my talking and wait my turn.

White Binder:

- The white binder should be with you at all times; when traveling between classes, when you go home and when you come back to school the next day.
- Students must copy down upcoming tests or quizzes onto their Assignment Calendar when assigned.
- On Monday's, you will receive your 'take home papers' from the previous week. It is the students responsibility to make sure parents review 'take home' papers.
- Leave your graded papers at home.

Dress Code:

Please refer to the updated 2022-2023 Dress and Grooming Code on the <u>BISD Website</u> Some Highlights:

- Hairstyles or designs that are disruptive or distracting to the school environment are prohibited (i.e. Mohawks, rattails, patterns or shavings in the hair, or spikes). Color that is disruptive or distracting to the school environment is prohibited (i.e. colors other than natural hair colors).
- SHIRTS: Shirts must be worn at all times while in the classroom, on school grounds, or at school-related or school-sponsored events. Shirts and dress tops must have straps and must be worn on the shoulder. Undergarments should not be visible. Midsection may not be exposed. Excessively large armholes are prohibited.
- LENGTH OF CLOTHING: Shorts, skirts, skorts, or dresses must reach mid-thigh range or longer. Shorts of any style must have at least a 4 inch inseam. The same standard applies to slits or slashes in shorts, skirts or dresses. A shirt worn over leggings must meet length requirements for dresses.

Restroom Behavior:

- Remember: Four or More, Back out the Door!
- Use the restroom quickly and return to class.
- Do not play in the restroom, keep voices quiet.
- Use the toilet, sink, and dryer appropriately.
- Do not take any classroom supplies into the restroom.

Cafeteria:

Pick up and put your trash in the garbage cans.

Report accidents and spills to custodians immediately.

In seat until dismissed.

Drink and eat in your seat. Only eat what you've chosen or brought from home.

Eliminate sharing food and "cutting" in line.

Always walk in the cafeteria!

Transitions:

- Face forward in a single file line and walk silently through the hallways with your hands to yourself. Practice social distancing in the hallways.
- Walk into the classroom and begin working quietly without disruptions.
- Disruption = touching, pushing, giggling, loud talking, etc.

Grading:

• If you make a grade below a 70 on an assignment (not tests) you may make corrections for a maximum grade of 70.

Corrections must be made using in red ink.

Do not erase the original answer.

The paper should be signed by a parent, and returned to the subject teacher by the Friday of that week for a maximum grade of 70.

• Tests-Reteaching must take place prior to retesting. A maximum grade of 70% will be recorded when re-doing, re-testing and/or reassessing for any failed grade.

Homework:

• Unfinished classwork that has been assigned for a daily grade can be sent home for completion. This work should be completed by the student and returned the following school day.

End of the Day:

- Do not change your transportation without a note.

 Walk in the hallways and on sidewalks. Walk bikes and scooters to the end of the sidewalk at Herff Ranch Blvd. You may ride once you reach the STOP sign. School dismissal is at 3:00.
