



# 3RD GRADE NEWSLETTER

<p><b>Math</b> <b>Module 7</b> <b>(Lessons 12-14, 16, 18)</b></p>	<p>We will continue Module 7 – “Geometry &amp; Measurement Word Problems”. Students will explore perimeter as an attribute of plane figures and solve problems; determine the perimeter of regular polygons and rectangles when whole number measurements are unknown; solve word problems to determine perimeter with given side lengths; use all four operations to solve problems involving perimeter and unknown measurements; and use a dot plot to record the number of rectangles constructed from a given number of unit squares. <b>Vocabulary:</b> area, perimeter, compose, decompose, attribute, polygon, regular polygon, quadrilateral, rectangle, square, rhombus, trapezoid, parallelogram, pentagon, hexagon, heptagon, octagon, parallel, right angle, face, edge, vertex (vertices), base, cone, cylinder, rectangular prism, square pyramid, triangular pyramid, &amp; sphere.. <i>We ask that you please work with your student on studying multiplication facts to help build accuracy and fluency. <p><b>Science</b> <b>Unit 7</b></p>	<p>Students will continue “Unit 7: Investigating Ecosystems”. Students will describe the effects of environmental changes on an ecosystem and its food chains and identify the cause of a disruption in an ecosystem within its food chains. <b>Vocabulary:</b> community, ecosystem, perish, population, thrive, consumer, decomposer, food chain, predator, prey, and producer *Students can access science content by using the <a href="#">BoerneISD student portal</a> to log into Discovery Education.</p>
<p><b>Reading/Language Arts</b></p>	<p>We will continue to analyze and craft texts across multiple genres, including multimodal and digital texts. Students will review strategies and genres of a variety of text in preparation for the Reading STAAR test on April 16th. In writing, we will continue to develop our extended constructed responses to a text, and we will work to revise and edit our writing. In phonics we will review closed and silent-e, complex syllables.. <b>Your child can read nightly for twenty minutes or use I-Station in Clever. Reading nightly helps to build stamina and fluency with your child’s independent reading, please encourage your child to try a new genre.</b></p>
<p><b>Social Studies</b></p>	<p>We will continue our unit “Making a Difference in Our Community” and learn about several heroes that did something brave for their community: Harriet Tubman,, The WASP, and Todd Beamer. 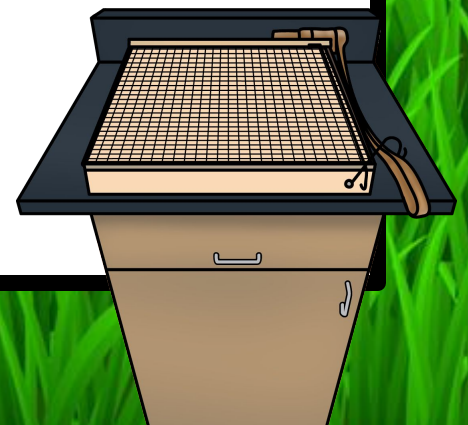
