Math Module 7

On Monday, third grade will take an "End of Year MAP Growth Assessment". This assessment is a resource we use to analyze the growth and progress your child has made, specifically in math, during the course of the school year. In addition, this assessment will provide a report that will highlight areas of strength and areas of difficulty for your student based on his/her performance since the problems encompass all of the third grade math skills we have learned throughout the year. A blue Module 7 DCA Study Guide Packet was sent home on Wednesday, May 1st in your child's red take-home folder. Please have your child return it (completed or not) by Tuesday, May 7th for our class review. Students will complete their Module 7 DCA on Wednesday, May 8th.

Science Unit 8

Students will begin "Unit 9: Investigating Life Cycles". In this unit, students will identify and compare the physical characteristics of young and adult organisms; describe and compare the life cycles of various organisms including tomato plants, wheatgrass, frogs, and insects. Vocabulary: life cycle, germinate, seed, seedling, young adult plant, adult plant, egg, larva. Students will receive their Unit 9 Study Guide on May 10th. Students will take their Unit 9 DCA on May 17th.

Reading/Language Arts

We will continue our novel study on Charlotte's Web by E.B.. White! We will be putting all of our reading skills into practice as we analyze and enjoy this award winning children's novel. In writing, we will respond to our reading, and work on our revising and editing skills, and analogies. In phonics we will build fluency with vowel teams and multisyllable words.

Your child can read nightly for twenty minutes or use I-Station in Clever. Reading nightly helps to build stamina and fluency with your child's independent reading, please encourage your child to try a new genre.

Social **Studies**

We will continue our Biz World Unit! Students were placed in groups and came up with their company name, values, and signed their business contract. They also brainstormed bracelet designs and explored advertising. Next week, students will manufacture their bracelets and decide on pricing. 2nd graders will visit our "store" on Friday, May 17 to buy bracelets with Biz Bucks!




