Definitions

- Confirmed Diagnosis
 - Any individual who has been diagnosed as having COVID-19 either by a physician or by a medical test
- Diagnosed Community Cases
 - The number of confirmed **active COVID-19 cases** in the **BISD community**, which includes the majority Kendall County, a small part of Comal County, and a small part of Bexar County that includes the City of Fair Oaks.
 - Active cases are determined by either the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) and/or Kendall County Emergency Management (KCEM). If BISD is unable to obtain accurate case data for all these areas

then the number of active cases will be determined as a factor (1.1) of the active cases in Kendall County.

- 7-day Average of Diagnosed Cases
 - The average daily active case count over a 7-day period. The purpose of a moving average is to not trigger operational decisions based on temporary spikes or lows in the cases reported.
- Campus
 - Any school within BISD, e.g. Boerne High School, Currington Elementary School, or Boerne Middle School South
- Cluster
 - Any group of students whose daily interactions lead to more than 15 minutes together within 6 feet.
 - For elementary schools this may be a classroom.
 - For secondary schools this may be a group of students who are in close proximity across several classes or an extracurricular team or organization.
- Closed Campus
 - A campus where all students have been moved to online learning in order to protect the health and safety of the students, staff, school families, and greater community.
- Quarantine Cluster
 - A group of students where all students have been moved to online learning in order to protect the health and safety of the students, staff, school families, and greater community.
