- Only vendor issued tassels are approved. These will be the same color/style for each student at a campus.


## Mortarboards

- Only vendor issued mortarboards are approved. These will be the same color/style for each student at a campus
- Nothing may be worn on the graduation cap/mortarboard except the official school graduation tassel. Absolutely NO decorations, religious or cultural symbols are allowed on the graduation cap/mortarboard. The appropriate way to wear the mortarboard is flat on top of the head and not off to the side or fixed to the back of the head.
