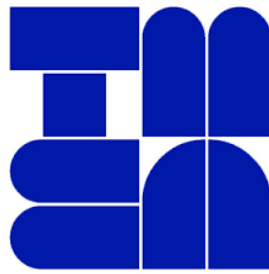

☆Pre-AP and AP Drop Forms are now available in the Counseling office. If your student wishes to drop a Pre-AP or AP course in which they are currently enrolled, they must return the form **by Friday, December 21st**. Form is attached.

☆AP Registration is now open. Please visit the Counseling Office webpage on the CHS website for the registration link and more details.

Taking the Advanced Placement exams is an important part of all AP courses. Boerne Samuel V Champion HS desires that all students take AP exams for the AP classes that they have taken. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn student's college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on tuition.

For the 2019 AP exams, students at Boerne Samuel V Champion HS will be registering online. This registration will take a few minutes and can be completed from any computer with internet access.

This year each AP exam costs \$98.00. Boerne Samuel V Champion HS desires that every student be able to take their AP exams. Students requiring financial assistance should contact Mrs. Natalie Walker, natalie.walker@boerneisd.net, in the CHS to learn more.

Online Exam registration is now open. In order to register, students should click on the link provide on the school website or visit www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/440732 to register .To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students have printed the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end. We know that parents may desire to register their students for exams. We strongly recommend that parents and students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered.

Boerne Samuel V Champion HS is excited to offer families the convenience of paying exam fees online at the time of registration. Please be sure to have a **credit card or debit card available before beginning registration**. Paying online is a great way to make sure that payment has been made while avoiding mailing payment.

Here are the important dates for the registration process:

- Thu, Nov 15, 2018 at 12:00 AM - Registration Begins
- Fri, Feb 22, 2019 at 11:59 AM - Registrations and payments after this date will incur a \$10 late fee per registration.
- Thu, Feb 28, 2019 at 11:59 PM - Registration Ends
- Mon, Mar 4, 2019 at 11:59 PM - Registrations that have not been paid for will be cancelled and exams will not be ordered.
- Thu, Feb 28, 2019 - Last day to cancel an exam and receive a full refund.
- Wed, Mar 6, 2019 - Last day to cancel an exam with a cancellation fee of \$20.00.

No student may exempt a fall semester exam. Fall and spring semester exams will be weighted 15% for all high school courses at all grade levels.
