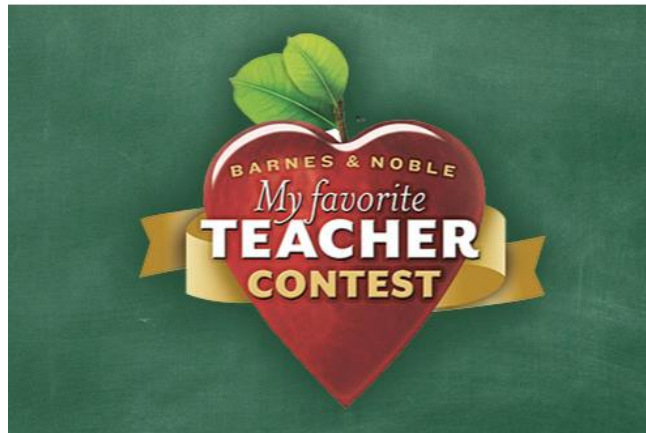

We are happy to report that Champion High School had 5 students advance through the Regional and Area levels and are moving on to State which will be held in April.

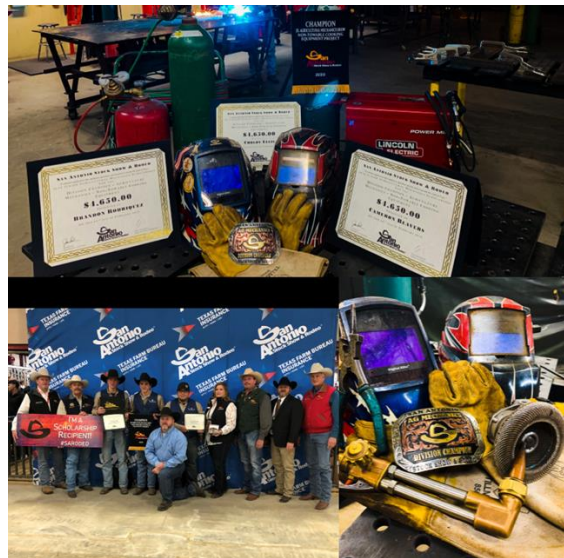

### DESCRIPTION
