Online Class Information

Student Planners

- You must have it with you <u>every</u> day.
- The student planner is used to record homework assignments, projects, and test dates.
- You <u>must</u> have your planner to leave the classroom to go to the restroom, locker, etc.

Materials for Class

• Bring all materials to class with you <u>every</u> day. This includes your planner, science INB, scissors, pen, pencil, colored pencils and tape/glue stick. (Composition books can be left in the classroom.) I would suggest having a zipper pouch with glue sticks or tape, colored pencils and scissors in your backpack.

Entering the Classroom

- Walk into the room calmly, grab any papers that are under the goggle cabinet and <u>sit at your assigned</u> <u>seat</u>. You should be in your seat before the tardy bell rings.
- <u>Update your planner</u> from the agenda on the board, and then <u>begin working on the Do Now</u>.
- Because of COVID-19, It is very important that you not wander around the classroom.

Leaving Class

- If you need to leave class (restroom, etc.), ask for permission, fill out the pass in your planner, then place it in the bin by the door. Sign out on the clipboard by the door. Upon return, sign the time in.
- You may not leave the first 10 or last 10 minutes of class.
- When the bell rings at the end of class, I will dismiss the students from class. Do not automatically leave when the bell rings.

Classroom Behavior

- No horseplay <u>at any time</u> in the classroom
- Leave other students' possessions alone
- No "side talking" when the teacher is talking
- Raise your hand and wait to be acknowledged before speaking
- Speak with good purpose
- Work cooperatively with peers
- When I need your attention, I will say "class", you will answer with "yes" and the room will be quiet.

<u>Furniture</u>

- Do not write on tables, chairs, or counters (even with an eraser).
- Do not lean back (or forward) in your chair.

Science Equipment

• Occasionally, you may enter the room to find equipment and/or lab materials on the counters, on your table, or on my desk. Please <u>leave all equipment alone</u> until you have been given instructions to use them for the activity that day.

Graded Assignments and Tests
