# The Board of Trustees January 22, 2018, Boerne Independent School District

**Donna Sharp** - Reported being impressed at the number of people who attended the first District of Innovation (DOI) meeting and looks forward to seeing results of that collaborative effort. There are thirty-nine people on the committee who will be determining what exemptions BISD wants to target for the innovation plan.

## <u>Carlin Friar</u> – Provided updates on several areas including:

special education and 504 meetings, reporting Dr. Holly Robles is doing a good job regarding drug/alcohol education;

the legislative action committee at the state level to conclude their work soon; and at the local government roundtable there has been great information sharing and a lot of collaboration between governmental entities in the local area.

<u>Rich Sena</u> – Noted that the first meeting of Government School finance task force meets tomorrow.

<u>Alan Rich</u> – Gave Budget Committee update on being budget focused and how to best use resources.

#### A. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORTS

1. Curriculum Audit

Dr. Tommy Price introduced Dr. Holly Kaptain, Executive Director for (CMSi) Curriculum Management Solutions, Inc. CMSi who did a presentation on the findings of the Curriculum Audit which was presented at an earlier time on the agenda.

The Curriculum Management Audit is a systems audit that does not focus solely on district curriculum, but on all departments (Finance, Human Resources, Operations,...) and how well the systems support the instruction of the students.

# 2. Parent Satisfaction Survey

Dr. Price presented the results of the recently conducted parent survey detailing the commitments below;

Boerne Independent School District is committed to creating a great place for students to learn, teachers to teach, staff to work, and for parents to send their children to receive a great education. To build on this commitment, the leadership of the school district gathers and analyzes data on essential goals and measures, including Parent Satisfaction. The district's continued journey of excellence using Parent Satisfaction goals aligned to strategic actions and appropriate progress monitoring measures based on the Evidence-Based Leadership<sup>SM</sup> framework began in Fall 2017.

The leadership of the district maintains a focus on data to identify gaps, take action, and follow through to ensure continuous improvement. The Parent Satisfaction Survey was administered to all parents/caregivers with a child in the school district to assess the level of satisfaction parents have with their child's school. Collecting feedback from parents/caregivers allows leaders to recognize the good work that many school leaders, teachers, and staff accomplish every day, and to identify gaps in performance that should be addressed.
