# Minutes of Regular Meeting September 15, 2014 The Board of Trustees Boerne Independent School District

A Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees of Boerne Independent School District was held Monday, September 15, 2014, beginning at 5:00 PM in the Administration Building, 123 West Johns Road, Boerne, TX 78006-2023.
