Course Description

ART 2 PHOTOGRAPHY 1 (6020)

Photography I introduces digital photography stressing composition (art elements and principles of design), digital darkroom techniques, computerized retouching, importing and managing of images, and print. The course covers digital photography using Adobe Creative Suite software, and archival photographic papers. Emphasis is on the potential to create a piece of art that can communicate in a unique way. Students have access to digital cameras during the instructional day.

Sketchbook

Sketchbooks will be utilized for taking notes, warm-ups, quick sketches, and planning projects.

Sketchbooks will be taken as daily grades throughout the year (monitoring progress and completion of assignments).

Art projects will focus on specific techniques and art mediums while also highlighting learned Elements of Art and Principles of Design.

CONTENT: project instructions, originality, and creativity

CRAFT: craftsmanship, use of technique

CONCERN: effort and focus, planning, use of time

CRITIQUE: self-reflection, taking good care of materials, helpful and kind to peers, behavior

50% MINOR GRADES: (9+/9 weeks)
