Course Description

ART 2 PRINTMAKING 1, 2, & 3 (6009)

Printmaking I-III: This course offers an introduction to the variety of printmaking techniques and is only offered at CHS. Students learn to create high quality prints using the following methods: relief, monotype, etching, silkscreen, and solar print. Additionally, students experiment with textures and manipulating images to enhance their prints.

Grade Placement: 10-12

Prerequisites: Art I for Drawing I, Painting I, and/or Printmaking I Teacher's approval for Level II-III courses

Sketchbook

Sketchbooks will be utilized for taking notes, warm-ups, quick sketches, and planning projects.

Sketchbooks will be taken as daily grades throughout the year (monitoring progress and completion of assignments).

*Bring your sketchbook to school EVERY DAY.

Grades

50% MAJOR GRADES: (2/9 weeks)

Art projects will focus on specific techniques and art mediums while also highlighting learned Elements of Art and Principles of Design.

CONTENT: project instructions, originality, and creativity

CRAFT: craftsmanship, use of technique

CONCERN: effort and focus, planning, use of time

CRITIQUE: self-reflection, taking good care of materials, helpful and kind to peers, behavior

50% MINOR GRADES: (9+/9 weeks)

Daily sketchbook checks, technique training worksheets, notes, planning, etc.
