

Arriving to school in the Morning



Students reporting to school (not eating breakfast at school) may arrive at 7:15 a.m. and report directly to their classroom. If you arrive before 7:15 am, please remain in your car with your student. Staff members will be on duty at 7:15 am. to walk your PK, Kinder, and new students to their classrooms. There will be no walk up drop off in the mornings.

Students eating breakfast ONLY may arrive at 7:00 a.m. and report directly to the cafeteria (students must be dropped off on the Chartwell side of FORES).. Once they have finished breakfast, they will walk to their homeroom classroom. **Bus riders who arrive prior to 7:15 a.m.** who are NOT eating breakfast at school will sit in the cafeteria until 7:15 a.m. by bus number.

Bus riders who arrive after 7:15 a.m. who are NOT eating breakfast will report directly to their classroom.



Dismissal Procedures

Parent Pick Up (Car-line)

Your child will sit in his/her homeroom by grade level on the side you have designated for pick up either Ralph Fair or Chartwell . Car seats/boosters should be on the passenger to ensure quick and easy loading of students. *Have your grade level name sign visible and ready for ALL students you are picking up.*

Walk Up Pick Up: We will NOT have a walk up pick up option until further notice.

Bus & DayCare: Students will remain with their homeroom class and their teacher or staff member will walk them directly to their bus. Students will wait outside with a staff member for their DayCare bus. Social distancing and masks/face shields will be required.

Walkers & Bike Riders: Students will remain with their homeroom class and walk directly to the Bus. Walker will follow the walking path inside the fence by the field and meet parents waiting at the corner of Dietz Elkhorn and Chartwell.





In order to reduce the number of healthy students who frequent the clinic daily for non-illness related visits, each classroom will be equipped with basic first aid supplies (i.e. band aids, lost tooth treasure box, etc.) to treat minor first aid needs.

As always, our nurse will be available to see students in the clinic who are ill, presenting symptoms of COVID-19, and any/all emergencies.

Recess will be by grade level. Each class will have a designated area of the playground that will rotate daily. Staff on duty during recess will enhance monitoring of student safe distancing.

Outdoor playscapes will be deep cleaned and sanitized at the end of each school day along with a disinfectant kit which will be used as required.

Computer, PE, Art, Music and Library
