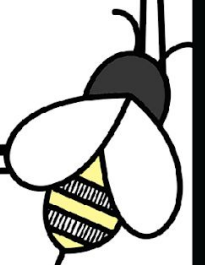

Begin speaking with your child about summer break. Prepare your child for changes by discussion summer plans (vacation, daycare, etc).





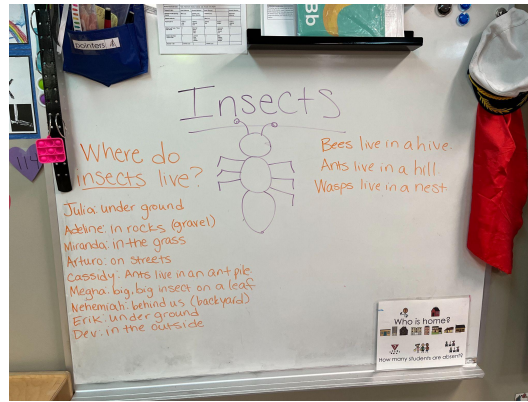
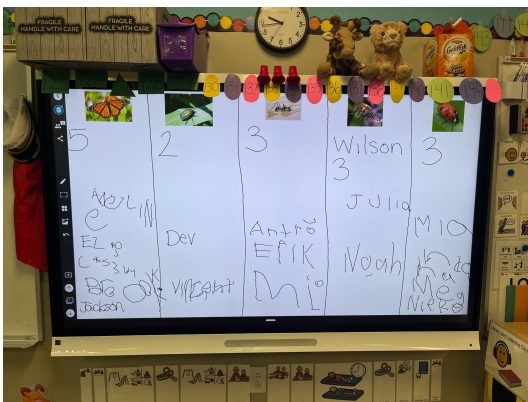
