



District Educational Improvement Committee Meeting Minutes

The February DEIC meeting opened at 4:32 PM. Dr. John O’Hare welcomed the group and briefly reviewed the meeting agenda. All pertinent information has been shared on the [DEIC Website](#). He requested input on the Title IV Survey which will be emailed tomorrow.

Ms. Kimberly Stewart reviewed Purpose of DEIC and Overview of District Improvement Planning Process - the committee meets in order to improve educational efforts District-wide. The Comprehensive Needs Assessment is next in the planning process.

Dr. O’Hare discussed the District Needs Assessment process and explained how it is connected to the Strategic Planning process. Our work focuses on updating the existing Strategic Plan and keeping it aligned to the four pillars: Student Success, Customer Service, Human Capital, Fiscal Responsibility. He established group processes and explained the groups would review the Strategic Planning packet and focus on giving feedback regarding our district’s strengths and challenges.

Ms. Krista Pomeroy reviewed the newly-created Portrait of a Learner, and a second exercise had attendees giving their answers by attribute to the question, “What would you like to see the school and district do to help these attributes be actualized in our students’ lives?” [Photos of group work may be found here](#).
