

Boerne ISD Classroom Library Use Agreement

Dear Parents/Guardians.

We want your student to read more! Reading is vital to vocabulary acquisition, linear thought, inferred meaning, and comprehension. In the classroom, students will study a variety of assigned works and master writing and analysis skills across content areas. Students will also have the opportunity to choose their own books to read independently.

The reading choice is up to the students to select. We want students to find books that they love.

Students should select works to read that are in keeping with your rules concerning text content. We have asked students to tell you about their selections, and we encourage you to ask them questions about what they are reading. Books are a great way to connect with your teen.

Classroom libraries are available for students to borrow books should you give consent.

Classroom libraries offer independent reading materials that support the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS). In Boerne ISD, classroom library collections are curated by the classroom teacher using Boerne ISD procedures for instructional materials selection (EF (LOCAL)).

Parent consent is **required** for secondary students to check out books from their teachers' classroom libraries. Students may also bring their own books or check them out from our campus library.

Parents should provide consent via Skyward Family Access. If parents do not provide consent through Skyward Family Access, their secondary student will be unable to check out classroom library books. If parents have further questions regarding classroom libraries in Boerne ISD, please contact your teacher or your campus principal.

Please complete the consent form via the Skyward Family Portal by August 18, 2023. Instructions are on the back of this letter.



How to access and complete the Boerne ISD Classroom Library Use Agreement form in Skyward

First, from Family Access, click on the ONLINE FORM Boerne ISD Classroom Library Use Agreement.



• Then, if you want your student to be able to check out books from classroom libraries click on the box next to Opt In- My student has permission to check out books from classroom libraries.

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Parents should provide consent via Skyward Family Portal. If parents do not provide consent through the Skyward Family Portal, their secondary student will be unable to check out classroom library books.
