DAY SERVICES

DAHS programs are Medicaid funded adult day care or day service programs. Programs provide daytime services, up to 10 hours per day, Monday through Friday, to people residing in the community. Services address physical, mental, medical and social needs. Individuals may attend up to five days per week, depending on their eligibility. Individuals must meet criteria. These programs are for individuals 18 years and older. Staff provides skills development training in a group setting. For more information contact your assigned Social Worker.

<u>VOCATIONAL</u>

Formerly called the Texas Rehabilitation Commission (TRC).
