Homework/Performance Policy

1. District policy will be followed for homework and late written work.
2. Special Assignments: Performances are due for all students on the first day scheduled. Students are given performance dates at least a week in advance. Late performances are not accepted. If you are absent on the day prior to a performance, you will still be expected to perform on the assigned due date. Students will not be allowed to skip a performance for another day. Students will not be allowed to "take a zero" by not performing. Tests and long range projects are due for all students on the date scheduled, even those who are absent on the day prior to the due date.
